**1. Building Energy Efficiency:** HB 1622 increases the energy efficiency of buildings in the state.  
Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

**2. Banning Invasive Atlantic Salmon:** HB 2957 effectively bans the practice of open-water Atlantic salmon aquaculture in the state of Washington.  
Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

**3. Healthy Food Packaging:** HB 2658 bans the use of PFAS (per and polyfluoralkyl substances) chemicals in food packaging.  
Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

**4. Oil Transportation Safety:** SB 6269 strengthens oil transportation safety by providing reliable funding for state oil spill prevention work.  
Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

**5. Toxic Chemicals in Firefighting Foam:** SB 6413 bans the use of PFAS (per and polyfluoralkyl substances) chemicals in food packaging.  
Outcome: Passed, Signed by Governor

**6. Orca Protection Act:** SB 5886 strengthens enforcement against harassment and noise pollution to protect orcas.  
Outcome: Senate passed

**7. Appliance Efficiency Standards:** HB 2327 establishes minimum energy and water standards for products that residents and workers use every day.  
Outcome: House passed

**8. Electric Vehicles:** HB 2653 expands incentives for electric vehicles.  
Outcome: House passed

**9. Nonnative Finfish:** SB 6086 protects the state’s marine waters from the release of nonnative finfish from marine finfish aquaculture sites.  
Outcome: Senate passed
